Dr Eric Dohner, MD is The First Physician in New York to Achieve Board Certification in Phlebology (Varicose Vein Treatment)

The American Board of Phlebology (ABPh) has awarded Diplomate Status to Dr Eric Dohner for completing a rigorous certification process and exam in the practice of Phlebology. The ABPh is an independent non-profit organization and was established in 2007 to improve the standards of medical practitioners and the quality of patient care related to the treatment of venous disorders and all aspects of venous disease. It also serves the public and the medical profession by establishing qualifications for certification and maintenance of certification as physician specialists in the practice of Phlebology.

In the spring of 2008, the ABPh administered the first Board Certification Exam in phlebology. The establishment of a Board Certification Exam brings recognition to both the field of phlebology and those providers in the field who have the knowledge, skills, and experience to provide quality care to phlebology patients. Board certification demonstrates a physician's commitment and expertise in a particular specialty and/or subspecialty of medical practice.
